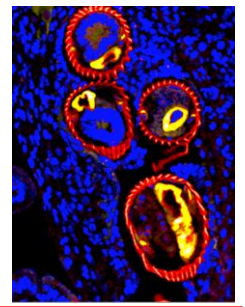




Parasitic Helminths: New Perspectives in Biology and Infection
